

Alpacas are considered to be “Green” because they are so environmentally friendly.

Alpacas are raised for their fiber and shorn once a year.

Alpaca fiber is hypoallergenic, stronger than wool and softer than cashmere.

Alpacas do not / cannot overgraze because they have no upper front teeth.

Alpacas are gentle to the ground because they do not have hooves, instead they have padded feet like a dog but with only two toes.

15 Alpacas have less environmental impact than 4 horses!

Alpacas are extremely quiet. Their main forms of communication are humming and ear pointing.

Alpacas are about the size of a Great Dane when they are full grown. Alpacas - adult weight about 150 lbs, height at withers 34-36"; Llamas - adult weight 300-450 lbs, height at withers 42-48"; Horses - adult weight 900-1400 lbs, height at withers 56-72".

Alpaca manure is richer fertilizer than cow manure.

Alpacas are a herd animal and do not challenge fences or wander.

Alpacas gestation period is 11.5 months. They don't generate a “Kennel” atmosphere or “Commercial” traffic.
