The deadline for orders is March 13, 2013. The date for seedling distribution will be Tuesday April 2, 2013 in Castle Rock. You will be notified of specific times and location.

Planting aids available to pre-order are slow release fertilizer tablets, water saving polymer, and weed barrier to aid in the establishment of your seedlings. These items are not required, but they are suggested to help in ensuring the survival of your seedlings.

- ↓ **Fertilizer tablets** - 10-gram slow release tablets, non-burning and formulated to last 2 years.
- ↓ **Polymer** - non-toxic granular material absorbs over 200 times its weight in water and releases to trees as needed.
- ↓ **Weed barrier** is UV protected to last up to 5 years before it begins to break down.
- ↓ **Staples** are 6" x 1" and are used to hold down the weed barrier. 200 staples recommended per one roll of barrier.
- ↓ **Gopher Traps** are well constructed to catch root eating pocket gophers without using poisoned bait.

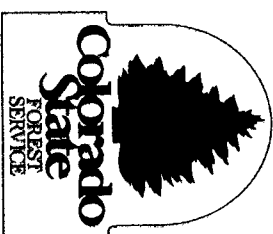
